These World Championships will be organized following the 2017 FIG Statutes, the 2017 Technical Regulations, the 2017-2020 RG Code of Points as well as all other Rules and Guidelines valid starting 01 January 2017 onwards, any possible amendments by the date of these World Championships, and any complements decided in the meantime.

All participating Federations commit to abide by the Statutes and all FIG Rules and Regulations. Federations not respecting them will not be allowed to compete.

## 5. PARTICIPATION RIGHT AND ACCREDITATIONS

Senior Gymnasts holding a valid FIG License and with the correct age from FIG affiliated member federations in good standings may take part in these World Championships.

### Participation right for Individual Competitions:

- Unlimited participation. All National Federations are entitled to participate either with 1 or 2 Individual gymnasts

### Participation right for Group Competitions:

- all National Federations are entitled to participate with one Group

The FIG Accreditation Rules and Media Rules have to be strictly respected.

## **6. AGE LIMIT OF GYMNASTS**

All participants must be minimum 16 years old in the year of the event (i.e. born in 2001 or earlier).

## **7. REGISTRATIONS AND ENTRY FEES**

Registrations can only be made by FIG affiliated federations in good standing.

### Provisional Registration

The provisional registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation via the FIG online database system (<http://www.fig-gymnastics.com>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations login and password, from now until **26 April 2017** (23h59 Swiss time) at the very latest.

### Definitive Registration

The definitive registrations must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation via the FIG online database system (<http://www.fig-gymnastics.com>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations login and password, from 27 April 2017 until **24 May 2017** (23h59 Swiss time) at the very latest.

Definitive registrations received in the FIG Offices after the drawing of lots will be refused (i.e. the gymnasts will not be allowed to compete).

### Nominative Registrations

The nominative entries must be completed by entering the composition of the delegation via the FIG online database system (<http://www.fig-gymnastics.com>) and by using the National Gymnastics Federations login and password, from 25 May until **26 July 2017** (23h59 Swiss time) at the very latest.

## Entry Fees

The non-reimbursable registration fees to be paid to the FIG amount to:

CHF 50.- per Individual Gymnast

CHF 200.- per Group

The total amount of the entry fees must be paid until the date of the definitive registration deadline, **24 May 2017 at the very latest.**

Registrations without the appropriate payment of the entry fees within the given deadline will be considered as invalid (i.e. the gymnasts will not be allowed to compete).

## Fines for missing or late registrations

### **FIG fines:**

The fines after missing the Registrations deadlines or after late Registrations are as follows (as per the Technical Regulations):

#### **Change requests:**

After the deadlines, a **change request** has to be submitted to the LOC in written form. A fee of EUR 20 will then be charged per change request. Fees for changes request are in addition of cancellation costs.

**Names changes as allowed in the FIG Technical Regulation and cannot be fined.**

## **8. LICENSES**

The LOC will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts' Licenses. **No gymnasts will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the deadline of the Nominative Registration.**

In order to be considered, Licence application forms (new or renewal) must be submitted at least one (1) month prior to the deadline for nominative registration. Please consult FIG License Rules for additional information in this respect.

## 9. JUDGES

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Only judges with the appropriate and valid category of brevet (Cat. 1-3) for their function for this XIV Cycle (2017-2020) will be authorized to judge in Pesaro. The FIG brevetted judges are designated by their National Federation.

Judges are requested to arrive in Pesaro one day before the respective Judges' Instruction at the very latest, and to be available until the last day (Final) of the respective competition (Individual and/or Group) they have been registered in by their NF.

According to the FIG TR 2017, section 3, Reg. 5.1.2, each National Federation participating with 1 or 2 Individual gymnasts **and/or** one Group may present **one** qualified judge.

### Clarification:

National Federation participating with 1 or 2 Individual gymnasts may register one (1) judge with a valid category of RGI brevet.

National Federation participating with one Group may register one (1) judge with a valid category of RGG brevet.

National Federation participating with 1 or 2 Individual(s) and one Group may register one (1) judge with a valid category of RGI and RGG brevet (= a total of one (1) judge only, i.e the same judge will judge both Individual and Group competitions).

According to the FIG TR 2017 Reg. 7.8.2, the General Judges' Rules and the current valid RG Code of Points, the composition each Judges' Panel consists of a total of 12 judges as follows:

### **Difficulty (D) – Category 1 or 2:**

- First sub-group: 2 judges (D1 and D2)
- Second sub-group: 2 judges (D3 and D4)

### **Execution (E) – Category 1, 2 or 3:**

- First subgroup: 2 judges (E1, E2) evaluate the Artistic faults
- Second subgroup: 4 judges (E3, E4, E5, E6) evaluate the Technical faults

### **Reference (RET) – Category 1 or 2:**

- Reference judges: 2 judges (RET1 and RET2)

### **+ Assistants – Category 1, 2 or 3:**

- Time Judges: 1 judge (T)
- Line Judges: 2 judges (L)

The selection of the judges is made by draw during the Judges' instruction and the Judges briefings prior to each competition, taking into consideration the degree of the brevet, according to the Judges' Rules. The preference is always given to the judges with the highest qualification.

**All** Judges will be "labelled" according to their nationality, i.e. they are presented as representing their NF on scoreboards, on printed judges' lists and results, in TV graphics, etc.

In the Finals by Apparatus only judges whose federations do not have competitors, nor a No 1 reserve Individual Gymnast/Group taking part, may be called upon to judge. The selection is by means of the drawing of lots.

If there are insufficient judges, the FIG Technical Committee decides the process for designating the necessary number of judges.

### Jury of Appeal

The composition of the Jury of Appeal will be communicated in the Workplan.

## 10. DRAWING OF LOTS

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The drawing of lots will decide the starting order of the qualification competitions and the finals. It will take place within two weeks after the deadline of the definitive entry. The exact date, time and location will be announced in due course by the FIG to the parties concerned which are entitled to be present at the draw.

## 11. COMPETITION FORMAT AND PROGRAMME

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The competitions will be conducted according to the 2017 FIG Technical Regulations, including Section 3 for Rhythmic Gymnastics, Reg. 5.

### Individual Competitions:

- Qualifications for All-Around and Apparatus Finals:
  - All Individual Gymnasts
  
- All-Around Final:
  - 24 best gymnasts from the qualifications
  
- Apparatus Finals.
  - 8 best gymnasts of the qualifications on each of the 4 apparatus

### Group Competitions:

- General Competition and qualifications for Apparatus Finals
  - All-Around ranking
  
- Finals for the Exercise using one and two types of apparatus
  - 8 best Groups of the qualifications on 5 Hoops
  - 8 best Groups of the qualifications on 3 Balls and 2 Ropes

## 12. PUBLICITY

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As the Code of Points foresees deductions should the FIG Publicity rules on attire and equipment not be respected, each federation may fill-in the online FIG Publicity form if deemed necessary from now till 26 July 2017, at the very latest in order to have it approved.

## 13. EQUIPEMENT

## 14. VISA

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Please verify immediately with your travel agent or the Italian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Italy. The LOC will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before **24 May 2017** to the LOC. The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport

number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation Member as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

## 15. TRANSPORTATION

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The international travel to Pesaro will be at each delegation's own expenses. The FIG and the LOC strongly recommend that each Federation take a cancellation insurance for their international transportation.

### Local Transportation

The LOC offer free local transportation for all accredited persons provided that the delegations stay at one of the official hotels, book their accommodation through the LOC, fill-in and return to the LOC their Travel Form (Appendix 2) by 26 July 2017 from:

1. International Airport of Ancona "Raffaello Sanzio" (AOI), (71 km - 1 hour from Pesaro)
2. International Airport of Bologna "Guglielmo Marconi" (BLQ), (155 km - 1h35 hour from Pesaro)
3. Main Train Station of Pesaro

to the official hotels and back. This service from the airport to the official hotels and back will be guaranteed by the LOC.

Bus service will be available for the local transportation of all accredited persons (if applicable) from the official hotels to the training, warm-up, and competition venues as well as to any other official activities and back as needed.

Federations that do not stay at one of the official hotels, do not book their accommodation through the LOC and do not enter their Arrival and Departure details online in due course, will not be entitled to use the event local transportation system and will be responsible to be on time !

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**22. DOPING CONTROLS**

Doping controls will be made as per the Doping Control Regulations of the FIG and WADA.

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**23. MUSIC**

The **Digital Platform** will be available starting from two months before the event. The platform will allow each Delegation to create a profile and upload pictures, music (.mp3 or .wga), and anthems. The Music can be downloaded as soon as the digital platform is open but by **26 July 2017 at the very latest**.

## 24. MUSIC FORM

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While the LOC guarantees the respect for the rights of author and broadcasting of the musical works, each National Gymnastics Federation will also have to confirm that the music used does not violate any copyrights and that it can be broadcasted within sports.

This confirmation will have to be made by filling-in the online Music release Form at the same time as the nominative registration. Each NF will also be requested to inform on the apparatus, duration, title, author and interpreter composer, title of music, and artist/interpreter of the Music used. The Music Form must be returned by e-mail in format excel to the FIG and to the LOC by 26 July 2017 at the latest.

## 25. ELECTIONS OF THE ATHLETES' REPRESENTATIVE

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The elections of the RG athletes' representative for the period extending from 2018 until 2021 will take place as follows:

- Friday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017, from 20:00 until 21:00

This election will be made according to the articles 22, 11.14.1, 11.15.2 and 11.15.5 of the FIG Statutes and based on the candidatures received. Not more than one representative in the FIG athlete's commission per Federation will be allowed. The assembly of the athletes will be open to two athletes per member federation. The election will be directed by the FIG Secretary General, accompanied respectively by the President of the FIG RG TC.

Candidates must be proposed by their National Gymnastics Federation as soon as possible, but by no later than **26 July 2017**. Candidatures must be accompanied by a CV (curriculum vitae) and a written confirmation whereas the federation will be responsible for the full costs of travel and lodging involved in attendance at meetings (including the expenses of any interpreters) should the FIG be unable to offer any direct assistance in this regard. An assurance must also be given that the candidate, if elected, will be provided with administrative support if required, and every facility to enable him to attend meetings.
