Preliminary entry deadline:	25.02.2017. *
Nominative entry deadline:	25.03.2017. **
Size of the delegation:	Unlimited number of gymnasts until quota. Min. 1 judge (fully acknowledged; FIG “brevet” judges are warmly welcome, but not obligatory) Coach/coaches LOC maintains right to limit no. of participants
Entry fees:	50€ per senior gymnast 40€ per gymnast in all other categories

**No inquiries, no Preliminary or Nominative Forms after deadline. Only changes allowed.

General Awardings:

All participating gymnasts will receive diplomas and presents

A program awarding: seniors and juniors

All around ranking: 1st – 3rd ranked will receive trophies and prize money.

Best 10 qualifiers from Juniors and Senior are going directly to finals. Final ranking is calculated from best 3 of 4 exercises.

Senior A program winner will be The Queen of Rhythmic Gymnastics 2017 and receive crown.

Junior A program winner will be The Princess of Rhythmic Gymnastics 2017 and receive crown.

Seniors A program prize money:

1st place AA ranked gymnast - 1000€ (one thousand Euro)

2nd place AA ranked gymnast - 600€ (six hundred Euro)

3rd place AA ranked gymnast - 400€ (four hundred Euro)

Juniors A program prize money:

1st place AA ranked gymnast - 250€ (two hundred fifty Euro)

2nd place AA ranked gymnast - 150€ (one hundred fifty Euro)

3rd place AA ranked gymnast - 100€ (one hundred Euro)

note: prize money is free of any taxes or other deductions

BEST COACH AWARDING:

Best coach – 500€ (five hundred Euro)

Accommodation:

Participating Federations and clubs must cover the cost of accommodation and travel expenses themselves. The below prices charged for hotel rooms, will not exceed usual hotel rates. Meals: The accommodation includes meals from Saturday 8th of April (breakfast and a lunch at the venue)

1st option: HOTEL "I", Ive Robića st. 2, 10000 Zagreb, Croatia

- 40€ per person/night for delegation members in double/triple rooms with half board, during the days of tournament
- 50€ per person/night in single room with half board, during the days of tournament

2nd option: Hotel Calypso, Lučko

note: Accommodation and entry fees are to be paid upon arrival and exclusively to the Local Organizing Committee representatives. All payments are to be in cash.
