## **10. Awarding:**

- Winners and prize-winners of individual all-around (FIG seniors and juniors 1st to 3rd place) are awarded with medals, diplomas and valuable prizes from organizers of tournament. The winner is awarded the tournament cup.
- Winners and prize-winners of groups all-around (FIG seniors and juniors 1st to 3rd place) are awarded with medals, diplomas and valuable prizes from organizers of tournament. The winner team is awarded the tournament cup.
- Winners and prize-winners of finals (FIG seniors and juniors 1st to 3rd place) are awarded with medals, diplomas and memorable symbol from organizers of tournament.
- Winners and prize-winners (2009-2014 and younger 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> place) are awarded with medals, diplomas and valuable prizes from organizers of tournament, 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place - with diplomas and valuable prizes in each age in Category A and B. The winner is awarded the tournament cup.
- Winners and prize-winners of groups (2009-2014 and younger 1st to 3rd place) are awarded with medals, diplomas and memorable gift from organizers of tournament. The winner team is awarded the tournament cup.
- The coach of the winner in individual program and group is awarded with a diploma and a memorable gift from organizers of tournament.
- Each participant will be given a memorable gift from the organizers of tournament.
- Judges will be given valuable gifts from the organizers of tournament.

### **11. Financing:**

### **The Entry fee:**

**EUR 50** per individual gymnast (**EUR 80** per any additional gymnast).

**EUR 100** per group.

Each participating Federation must enter at least 1 Judge (Brevet 1-4, 14th cycle). The Failure to do so will result a fine of **EUR 150** - to be paid to the LOC at the accreditation.

All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet for the respective discipline RGI and RGG.

### **12. Safety of participants and spectators:**

The International Federation of Gymnastics Rules of holding Rhythmic Gymnastics Competitions.

### **13. Insurance:**

Each member of the delegation should have insurance.

### **14. Music:**

All music must be recorded on CD and USB-flashcard. CD's in CD-DA format/USB-flashcard (clearly labeled with the gymnast's name, club, country, apparatus and category) for each exercise.

### **15. Official forms:**

All foreign delegations are kindly requested to bring their national flags and anthems.

### **16. Living Conditions:**

The organizing committee will cover the following expenses for foreign delegation (according to the composition of the delegation, paragraph 7):

- Airport Transfers
- Lunch for judge (1 meal a day)
- Meals for gymnasts (1 meal a day)
- Coffee breaks for judge
- Banquet for judge
- Accommodation of judge (Brevet 1-4, 14<sup>th</sup> cycle), gymnasts: 1 senior and 1 junior category with a valid FIG license.
